Please put them in the book drop by the main entrance.

Everyone entering the library will be required to wear a mask and sanitize their hands upon entrance. Staff will gladly pull items to be picked up curbside for anyone who cannot wear a mask for medical reasons.

Browsing appointments will be 20 minutes long. Staff will be able to assist patrons in finding books and other materials, but reference questions will continue to be handled via email (tmcevoy@cw mars.org) or phone. The public bathrooms will not be available during appointments.
