The Friends of the Lawrence Library begin our 58th year excited to have the Library open six days a week. With your generosity, we were able to support the Library throughout the Pandemic. In fact, we held our most successful book sale ever in March! This Spring saw the return of concerts and Art Gallery receptions as part of the rich and varied offerings at our library.

We welcome your participation at our many public events and programs for all ages. You can choose story times for young children and book clubs for families, teens, and adults. Children can enjoy vacation events, crafts, and seasonal activities.

The Friends provide information about the library and support numerous programs thanks to generous donations, FLL memberships by businesses and families, and our popular fundraisers. We just finished taking orders for our 3rd annual Bulb Sale. Thank you to those who ordered. We will be contacting you about pickup in early October. We gearing up to host our 12th Annual Wine Tasting on October 15th. We invite patrons of all ages to our Annual Used Book Sale which will be on March 17-19, 2023. We accept used book donations all year. We proudly offer to the community 17 passes for museums and sites and encourage residents to use them often.

The Friends meet monthly on the second Wednesday at 10:15 AM. We welcome you, your ideas and your support. We hope to see you.

## A Note from the Director

In our effort to accommodate patrons the Library remained open 6 days a week, Monday through Saturday from July 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022. From May 3rd through the end of June 2022 we resumed our pre-Covid hours of 5 days a week.

Thank you for your support of the Library warrant request to fund Monday hours (May 2022 Town Meeting). This funding allowed the Library to resume in July our Monday through Saturday hours which now include four evenings open until 8:30 pm. Our curbside no-contact service using the locker system (installed in May 2020) will continue as an opt-in service.

With the Friends support, the Library provided a diverse range of 626 adult, young adult, and children's programs, both in-person and online via Zoom. We also provided meeting space for 230 non-library programs. This past year, the Library offered 17 different museum passes which were also funded by the Friends.

Thank you for helping the Library remain vital to the community through your continued support of the Friends.
