We proudly offer to the community 21 passes for museums and sites and encourage residents to use them often.

A Note from the Director

The Lawrence Library remains open 6 days-a-week, Monday-Saturday thanks to your support to permanently fund Monday hours at the May 2024 town meeting and subsequent June Override vote. Monday hours are now funded as part of the town library budget and not a year to year free cash warrant.

With your continued support, the Library was able to continue providing our numerous programs and offering of meeting space to community groups. We provided a diverse range of **950** adult, young adult, and children's in-person or virtual programs (up 3%). We also provided meeting space bookings for **483** non-library programs. The library offered **22** different museum passes, also funded by the Friends.

Thank you for helping the Library remain vital and essential to the community through your continued support of the Friends.

I would to thank Friends of the Lawrence Library for your continued unwavering support of the library. As I prepare to retire in June 2025 after 19 years, it is knowing the library has your firm commitment will help during this transition period.
